

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE OVERSTRAND SHORELINE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE,  
held on 18<sup>th</sup> September 2014, in the Parish Hall at 7.30 pm

Present :- Mr.Partridge (Chair), Cllrs.Haynes (ex officio) ,Brittlebank and Vickers, Mr.West (Co-opted members) and D.Cllr..Fitch Tillett observing

1. Apologies for absence :- Mr.Reynolds (Holiday)

2. Members' Declarations of Interest – Taken as read

3. To consider the draft Minutes of the meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2014 . – These were found to be in order, and it was proposed that they be signed and published as correct. **Agreed Four for, One abstention.**

4.Matters Arising :-

Item 5 – Beach Damage. This is an ongoing matter. The question of the LDF was raised.

Item 6 – Transfer of monies. This has not yet been completed. Cllr.Partridge proposed that he speak to Mr.Wallace and Mr.Reynolds to expedite this matter, **Agreed Four 4 One abstention**

5. Report by the Chairman :-

Cllr.Partridge expressed his concern regarding the Coastal Footpath Signs which have been erected around the village where some appear to be misleading. It was considered that most of the posts holding these signs have not been secured firmly and need to be re-erected.

Cllr.Partridge had spoken to Norman Lamb during the recent village surgery when the possibilities of funding for coastal issues were again discussed, with a view to inviting Mr.Lamb to a meeting. It was considered that it would be prudent to include other coastal villages. St.Martin's church could be used, should it be felt that the Parish Hall would be unable to cope with large numbers. A date in late November would seem most suitable, and Cllr.Partridge proposed that The Clerk make enquiries at the Party Office in this respect, seconded by Cllr.Vickers, **Agreed unanimously**

6. Other Reports:-

Mr.West raised the question of FLAG, and that there was no water supply to the promenade,

7. Any Action to be taken :-

To allay rumours circulating in the village, the Clerk was asked to formally invite Mr.Farrow to the next Council Meeting to clarify the District's proposals to consider the possibility of making disabled car parking facilities at the foot of the east slope,
